











Measurement Guide

Please take some time to look at the placement of the fenders above and try to see which one might work for your fireplace. Before you begin measuring for your fender, you must first decide exactly where you want your fender to be. First, for the sake of measurement, there are only two components that matter: **the base** (the metal part that sits on the floor) and **the leather seat**.

The easiest way to visualize how your fender will appear is to decide how wide a seat you want, usually 6-7 inches. Next, determine where the ends of the seat will abut, and then imagine the base centered under the seat.
